The Wholesale Charge Deferral Scheme was introduced, amended and phased out by instruction of the Water Industry Commission for Scotland in response to the economic impact of the COVID pandemic.

It is a market principle that the Market Code should be no more complicated than is necessary. Retaining references to a WCDS that has expired runs counter to that principle.

It is a further market principle that the Market Code (and CSDs) in force on any given day can be established by reviewing the versions of the market documents for that day. There is therefore no need to retain out-of-date provisions in the Market Code for reference.
